One thing to keep in mind is that you'll be able to download the tools you need for free, but for some of the more complex ones you'll have to sign up. For example, Calyptix is a Wifi password cracking tool that is ideal if you want to check that the signal levels for the devices on your network are what they should be. I think you'll find it's the most flexible tool of all of them, and the range of information it will provide is second to none. IPStatus is a wonderful piece of free software which does a lot of things, but one of the things it does is allow you to check the strength of the signal. If it's not strong enough, it'll tell you so, and you can even configure it to alert you if your network is about to be disconnected. It's a fantastic tool. It was developed in response to a problem I'd had in the past, when I was trying to work out why 82157476af
